6. Evaporative cooler other than portable \$3.20
7. Ventilation fan - single duct, appliance vent \$2.15

11. Each hazardous piping system, 1 to 4 outlets \$1.65

14. A service charge of \$5.40 per trip will be charged for reinspection
over those required by code.

F. BUILDING MOVING

1. Building or structure requiring a permit under
Chapter 162 of City Ordinance \$10.00

G. DEMOLITION

1. Building or structure in "B-2" Central Business District
more than one story in height \$10.00

H. COMMUNICATION TOWERS

1. Towers between 40 and 125 feet in height (between the base of tower and the top of the tower or the top of the highest appurtenance mounted on a tower) \$7.00
2. Towers in excess of 125 feet in height - fees in valuation schedule "A" apply
3. Exemption - All towers between 40 and 125 feet in height which are located a distance of more than the height of the tower from any adjacent property line or habitable structure shall be exempt.
