

City of Vinton
Sidewalk Reimbursement Program Application

The City of Vinton has a sidewalk program that may (if funds allow) reimburse a property owner up to a certain amount if the property owner proceeds to install or replace a public sidewalk in the right-of-way area abutting their property. The sidewalk must be installed according to specifications found in Chapter 136 of the Vinton City Code of Ordinances as well as applicable state and federal regulations. Any property owner wishing to take advantage of this program is required to contact the Vinton Street Superintendent at 319-472-2768 **prior** to having a sidewalk installed or replaced.

The reimbursement program has the following parameters as set forth by Ordinance 1030:

Available Assistance:

- Up to \$750 per side of lot.
- City pays all of HC ramp cost and sidewalk part of ramp.

Requirements

- Sidewalk must have been installed in the last six months
 - Sidewalk and any accompanying ADA ramps must pass inspection by street superintendent (or designee) to ensure it is installed/built according to city, state and federal code
 - At least one side of property must be **completely** done, excluding corner ADA ramps.
 - Property owner must complete city application, one per address

 - Each request must be approved by City Council
 - Application must be accompanied by a legible copy of paid invoice
 - Assistance provided under this program cannot be used in conjunction with any other sidewalk assistance program offered by the city (i.e. Safe Routes for School)
 - This program is limited to residential housing only
 - This program will be done on a first come, first serve basis until the funds are completely exhausted
